



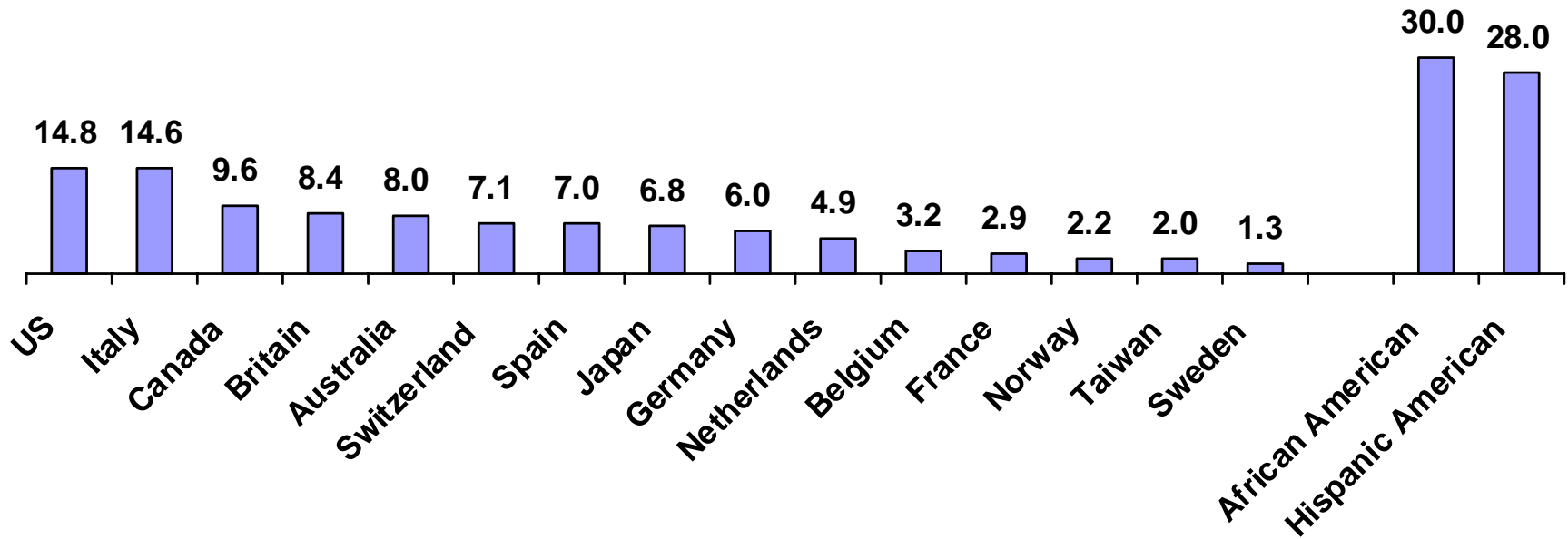

Percent

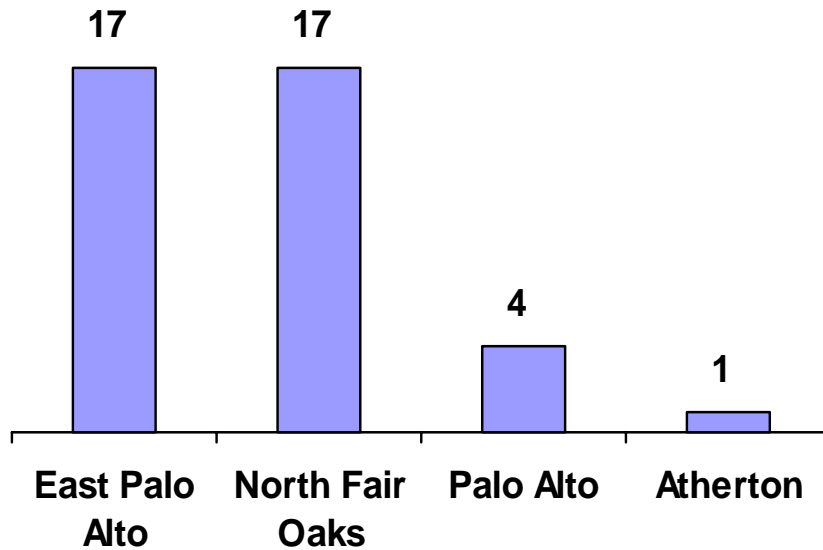

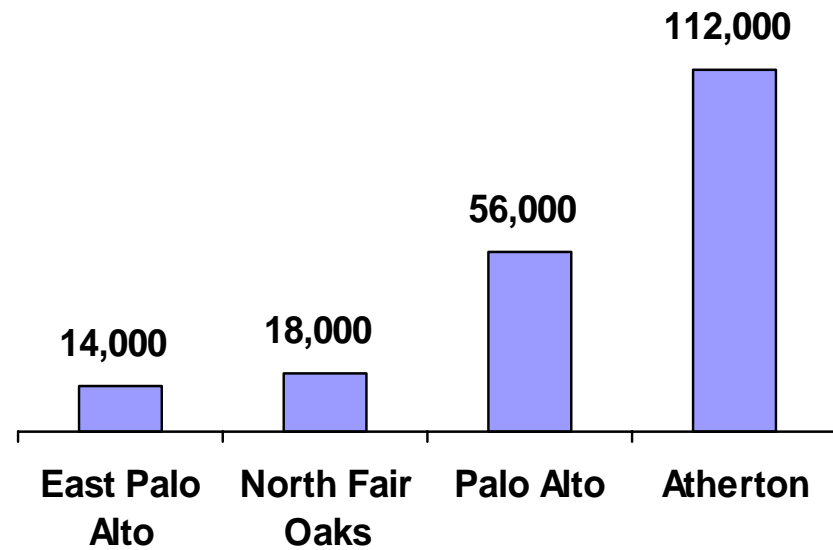

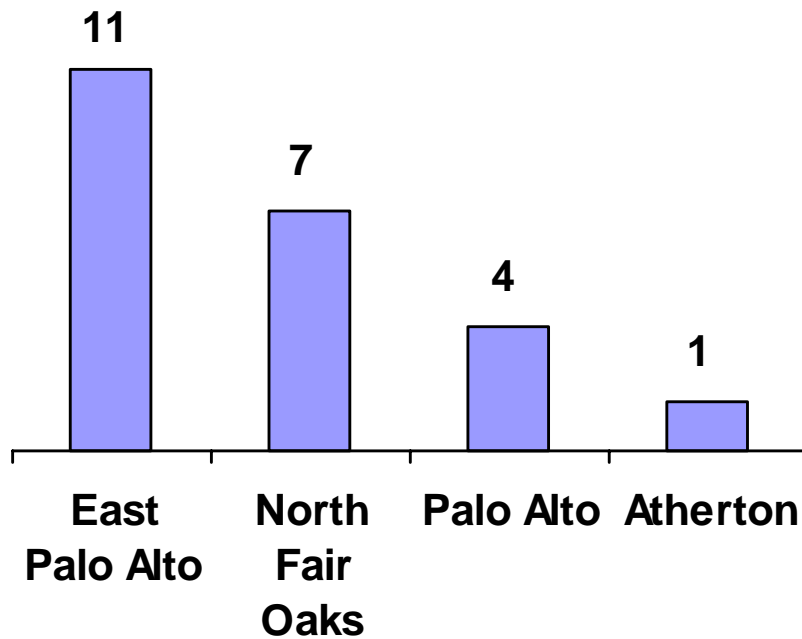

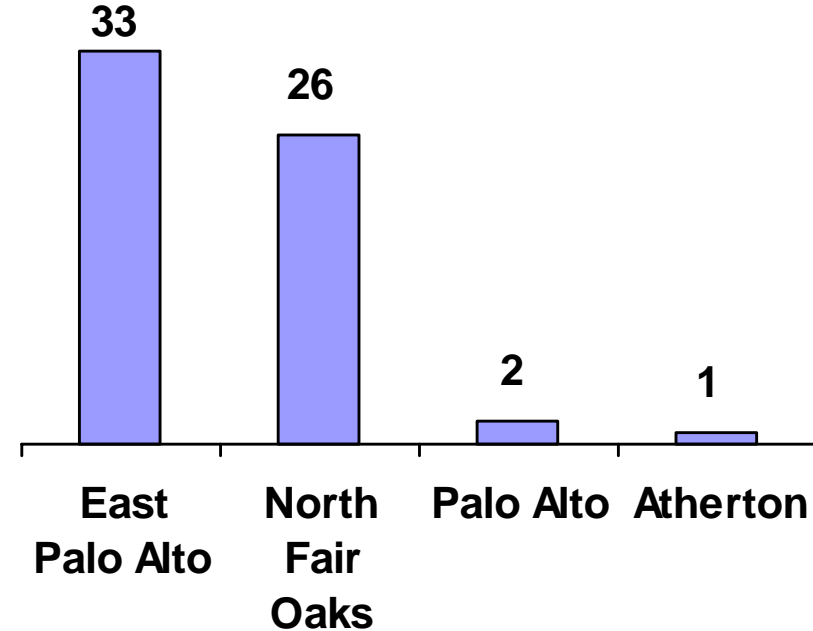

Percent

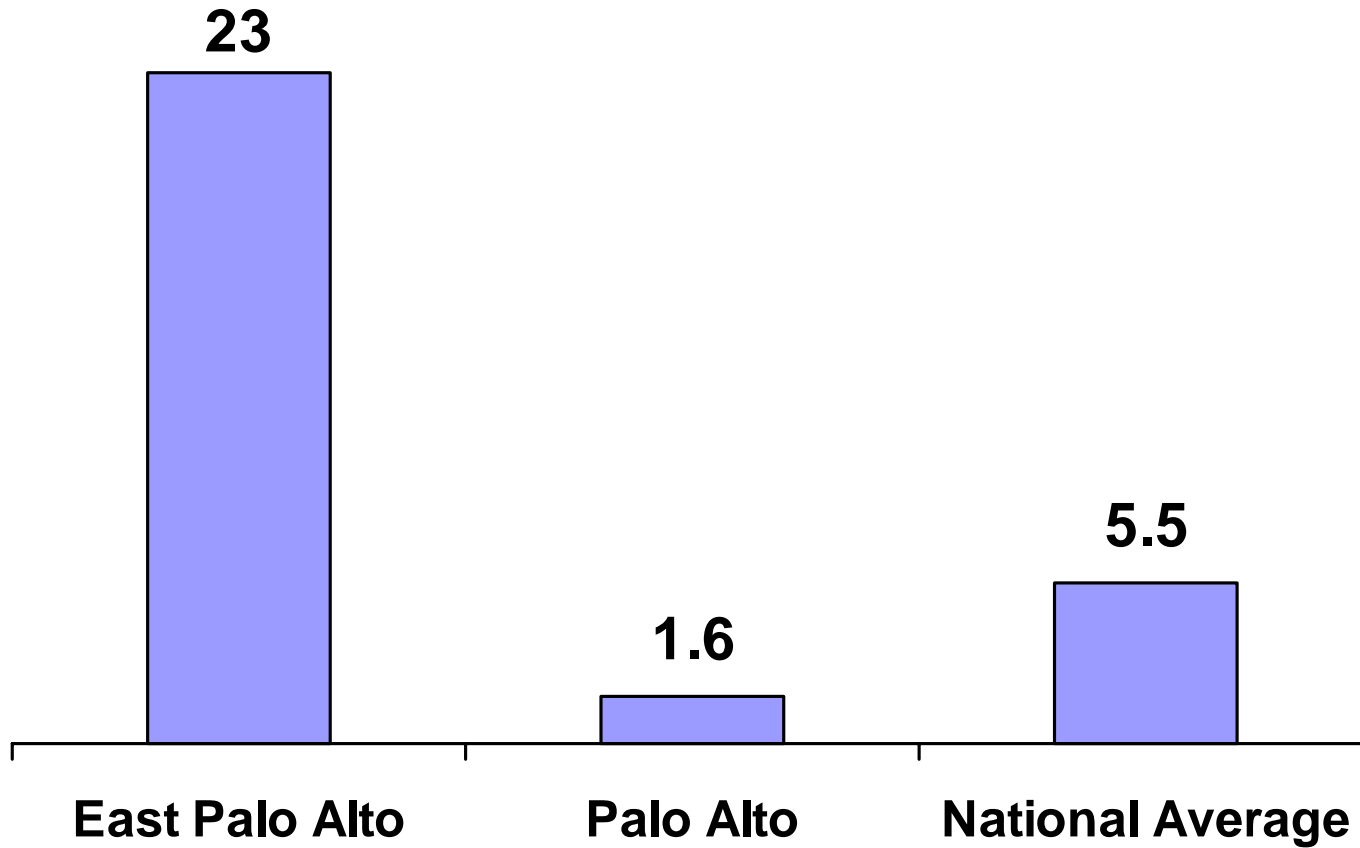


Households with >1.5 Occupants/Room

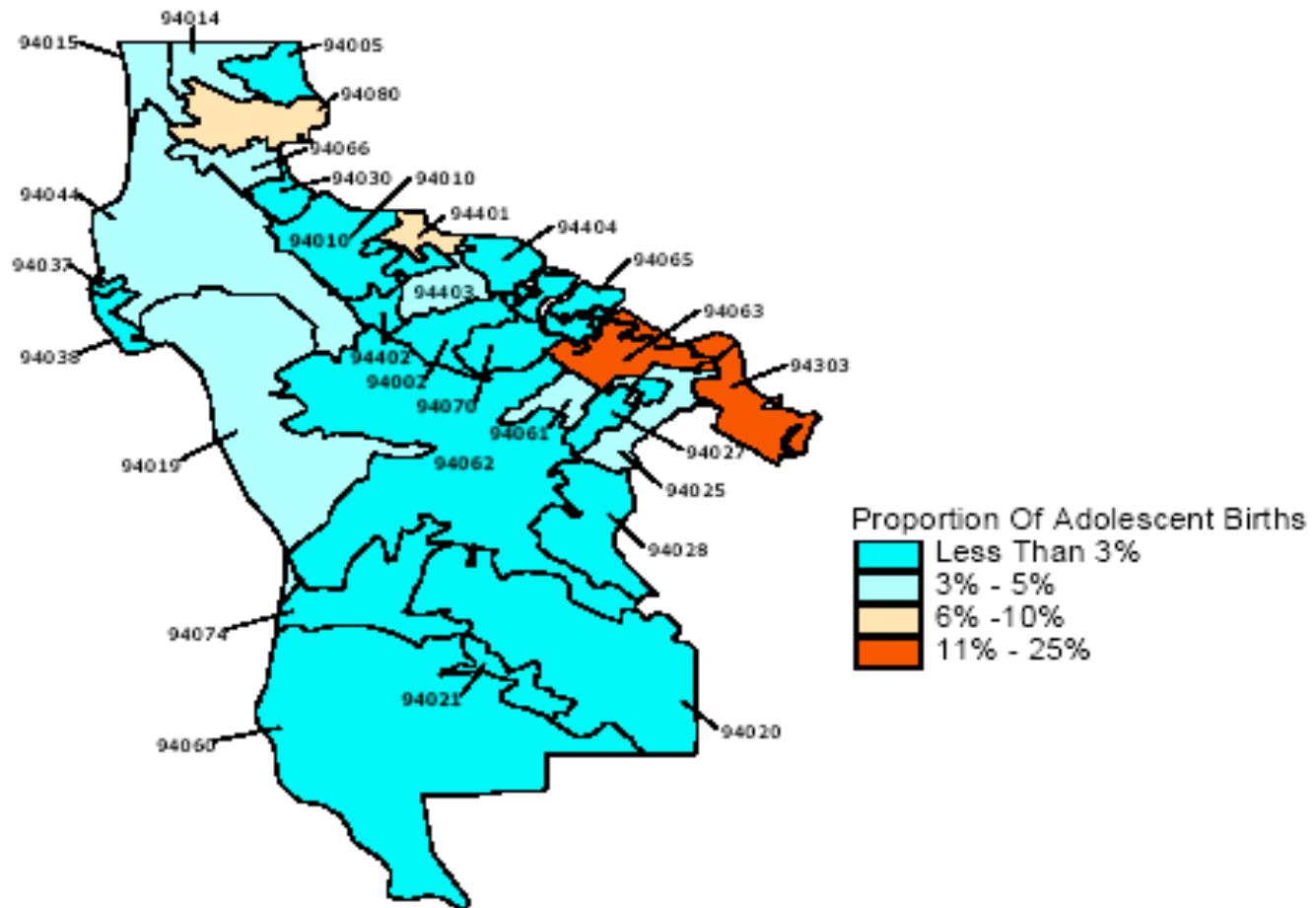

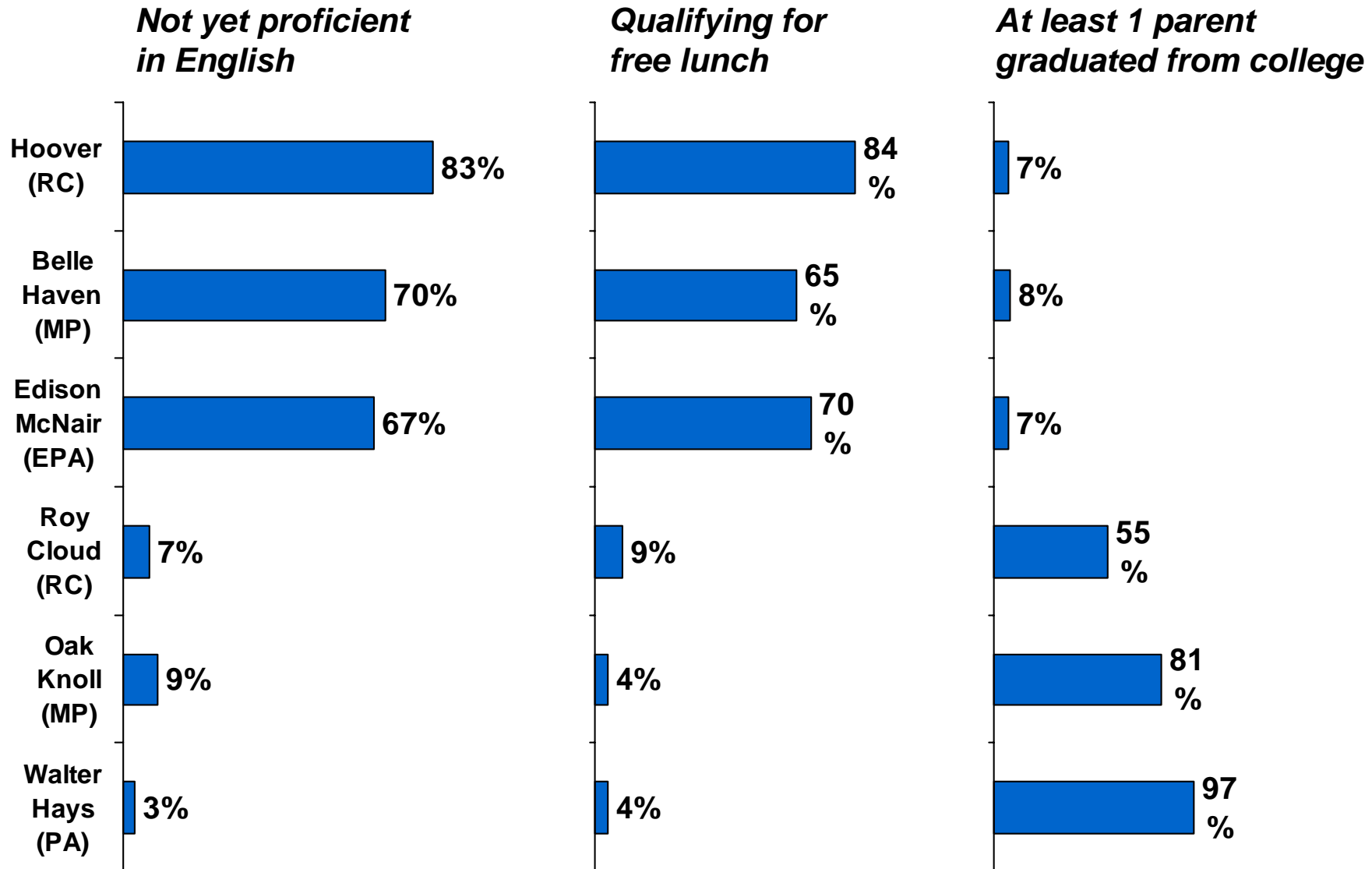
Births to Adolescent Females by Zip Code, 2002



Adolescents are defined as 17 years of age or younger

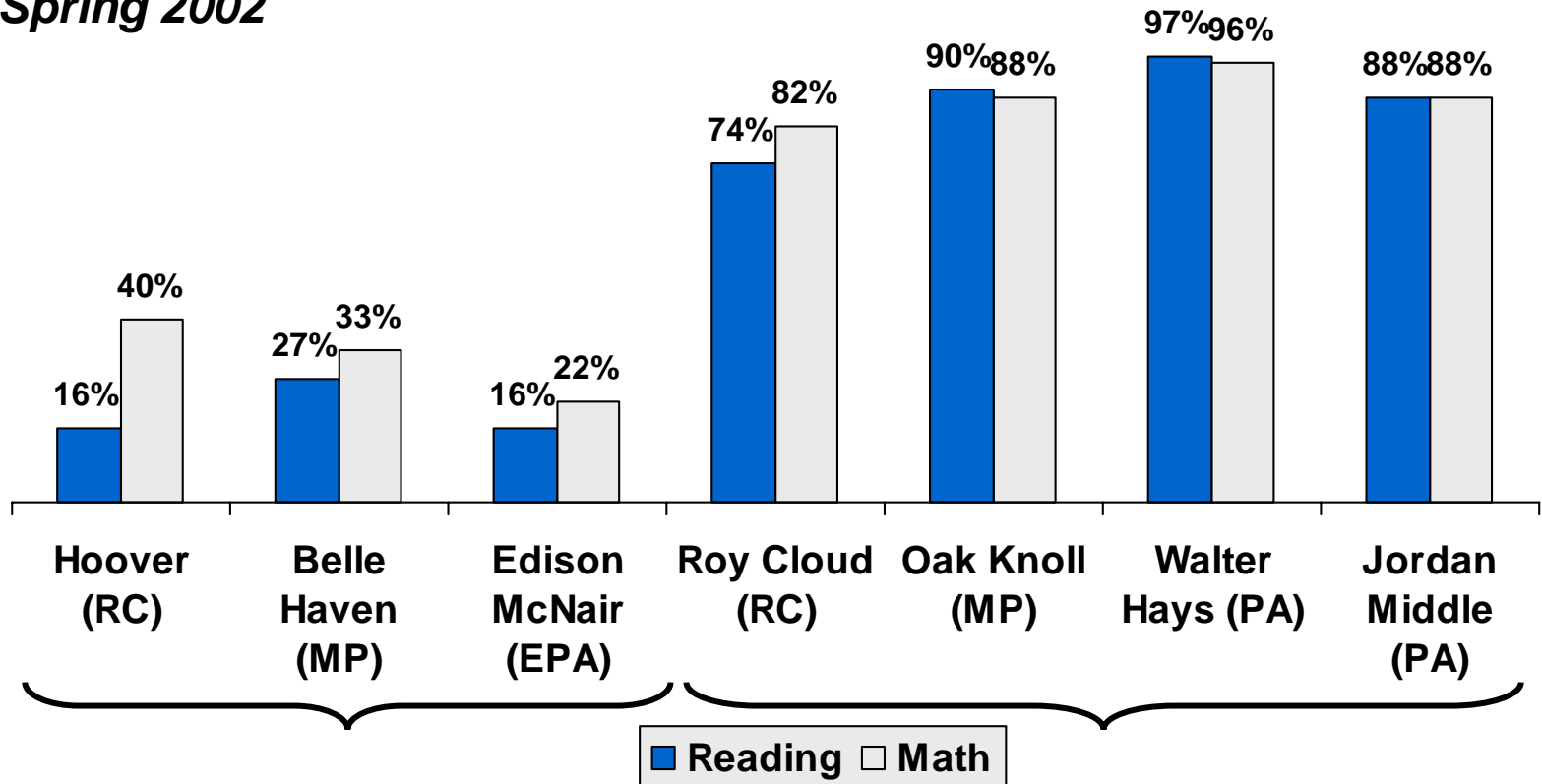

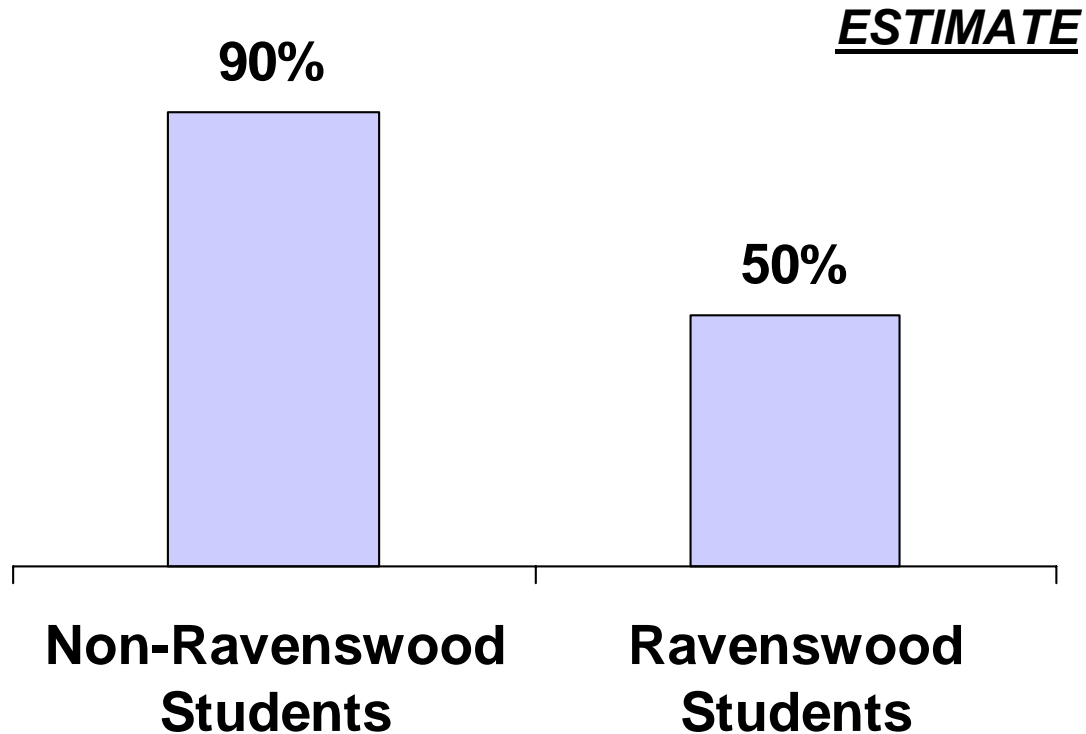

Sequoia District High School Graduation Rate

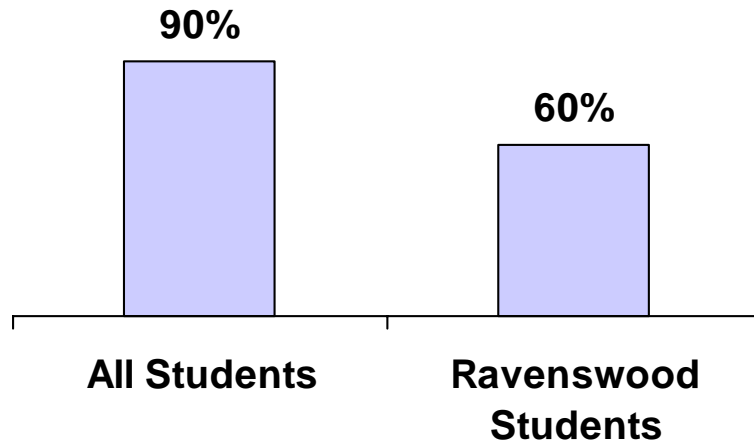

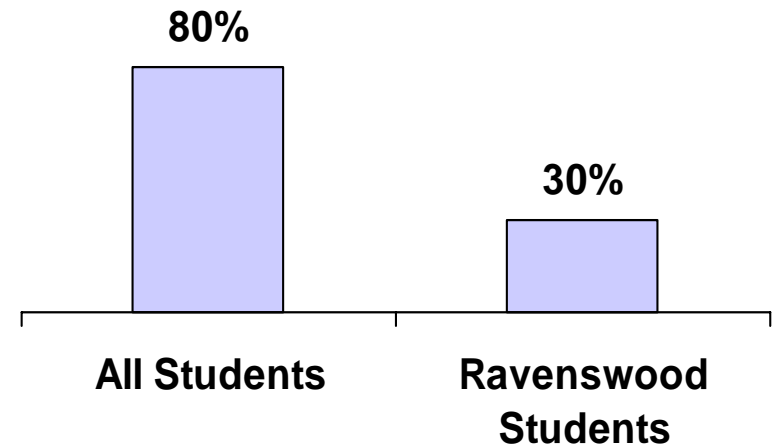

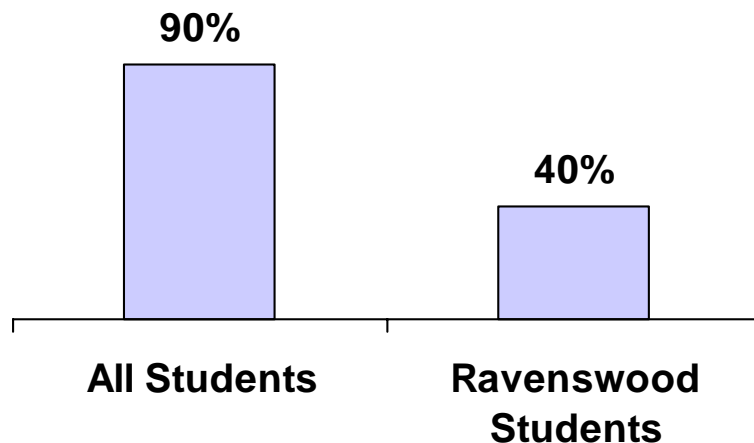
Freshmen enrolled in Algebra 1 or higher



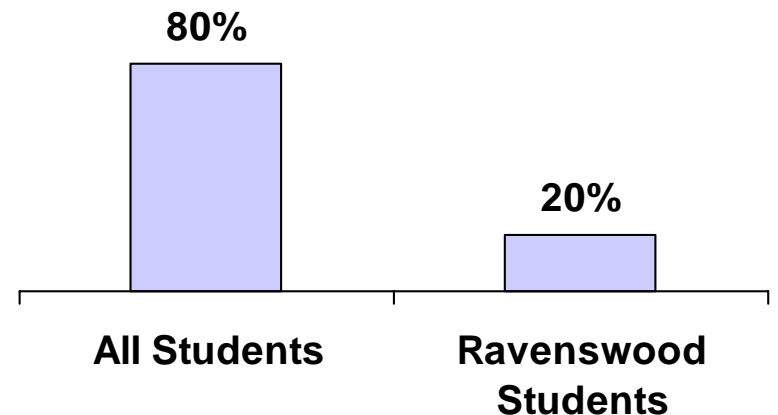
Sophomores at the next level



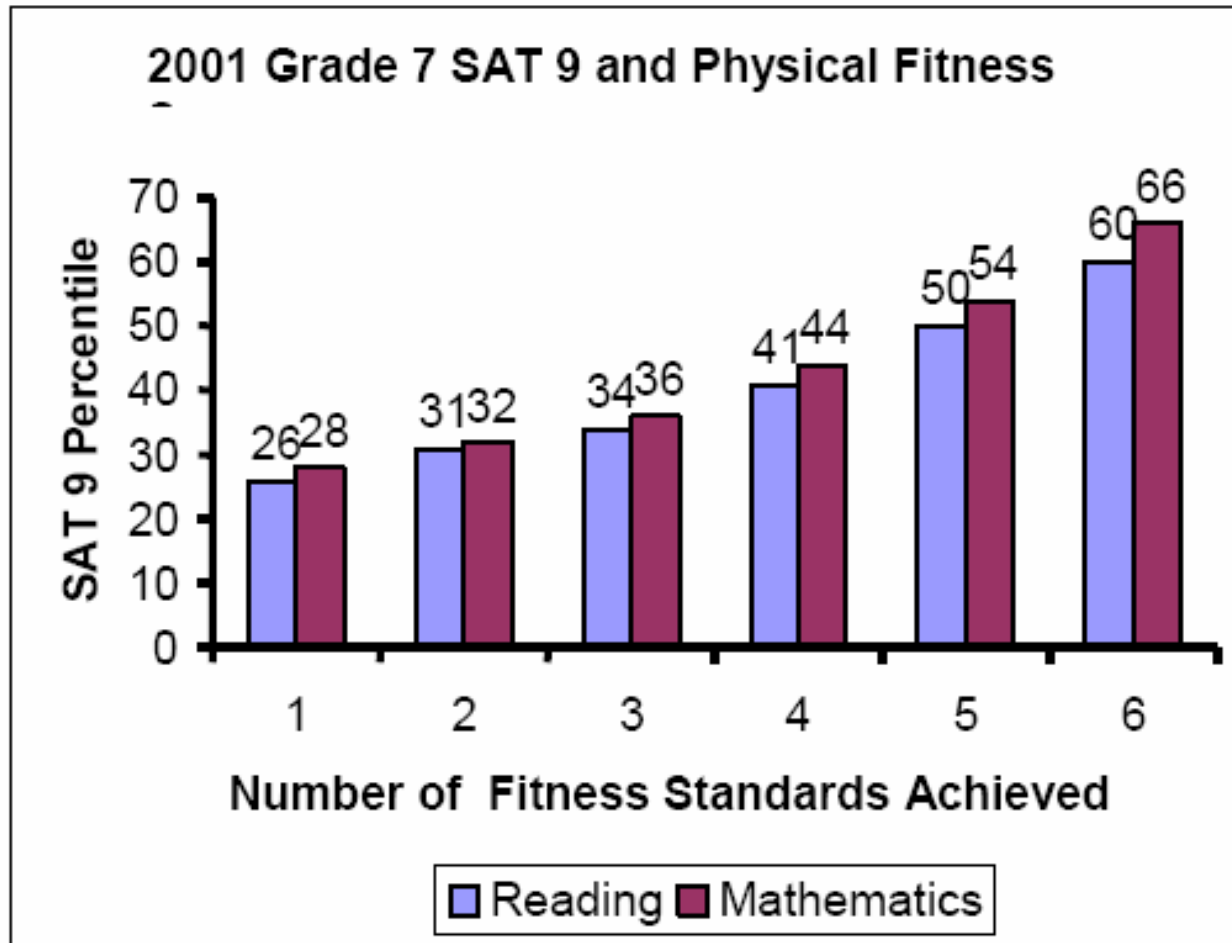
Freshmen enrolled in English 1

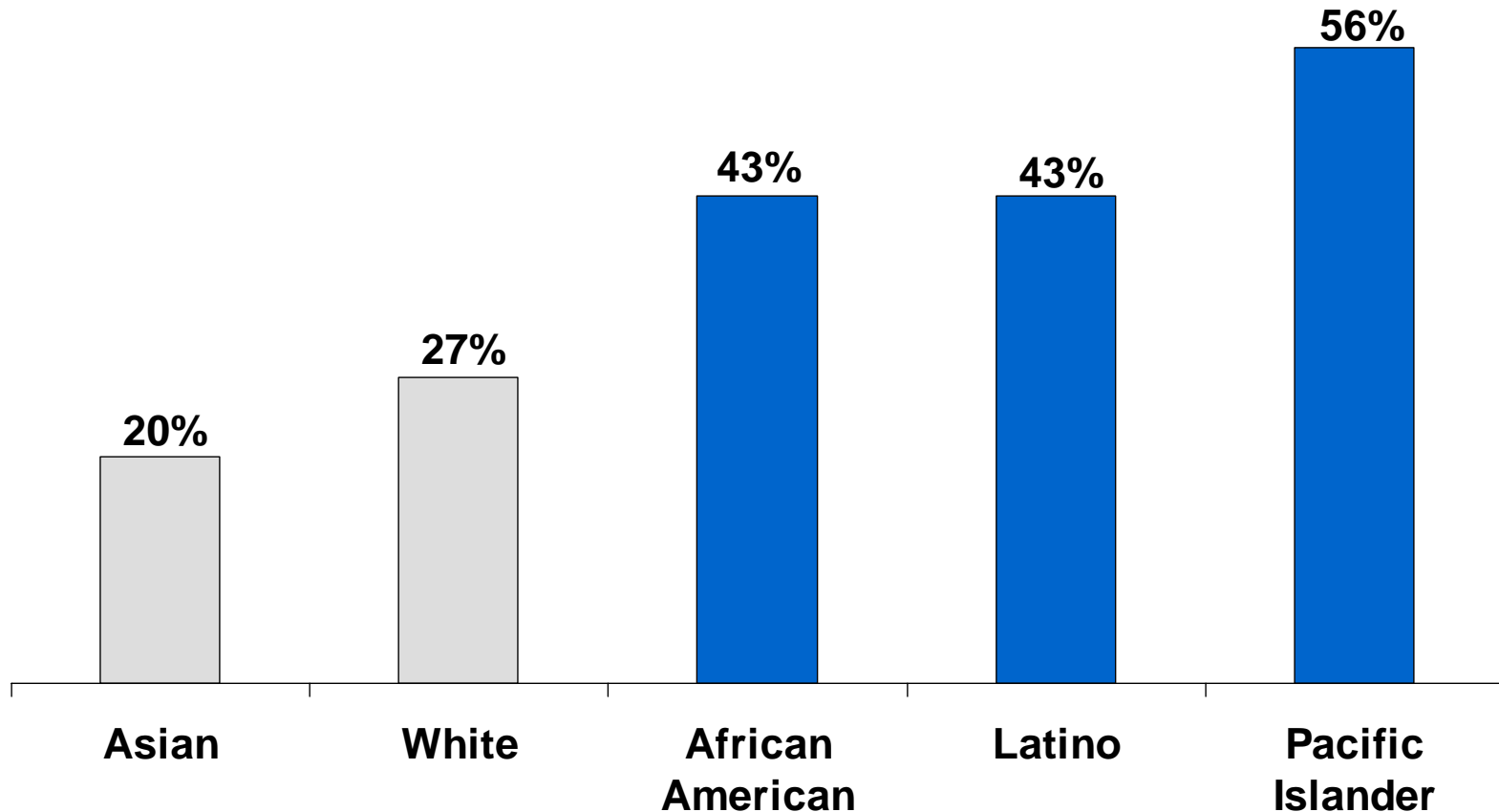


Fitness and Academic Performance II



In 2001, more than one million students participated in statewide physical performance testing mandated by Assembly Bill 265 in 1995.

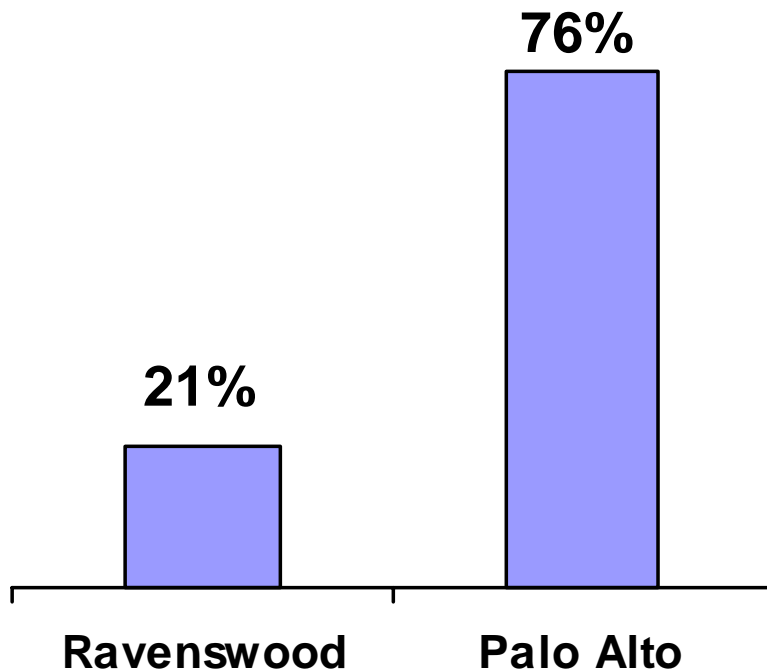
Overweight Rates in San Mateo County by Ethnicity



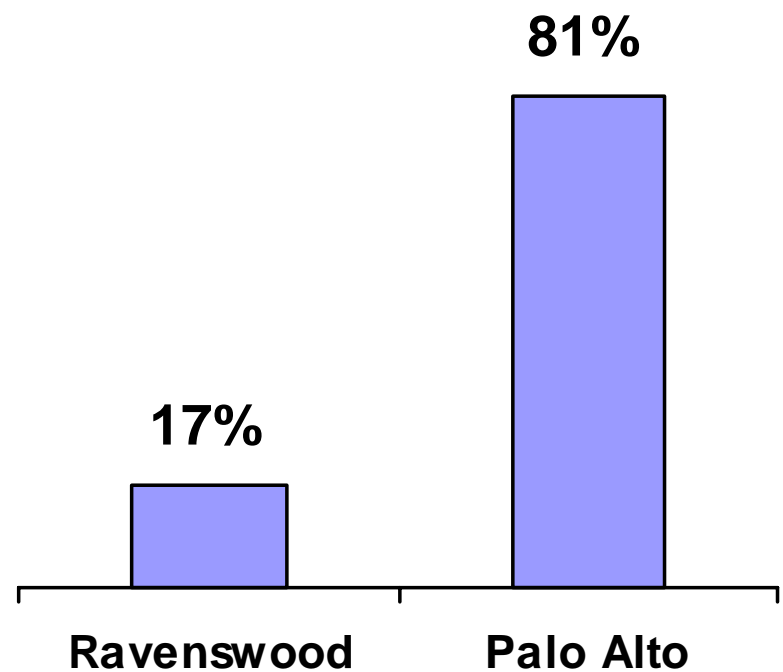

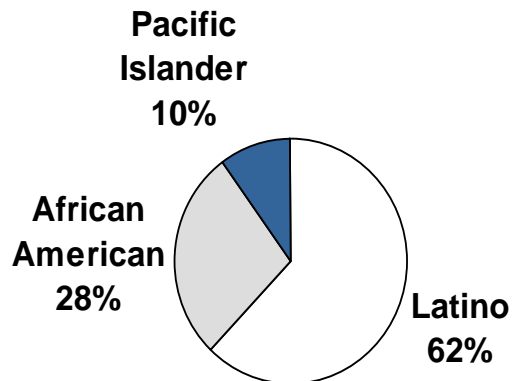
